







Ch 30

Theme – Specification for Altar of Incense; census tax (1/2 shekel); Laver of Bronze; description for anointing oil; incense

Ch 31

Theme – Call for Bezalel (head craftsman) and Oholiab (associate craftsman); reminder for the people to observe the Sabbath; gives Moses two tablets of the testimony, made of stone, written by the finger of God

Ch 32

Theme – Golden Calf incident

Ch 33

Theme – Israel sent out from Mt. Sinai; people mourn because God said they were an obstinate people; Tent of Meeting; God promises to go with Moses; Moses asks to see glory of God and God hides him in the cleft of the rock

Ch 34

Theme – Moses told to cut two tablets of Stone and God rewrote the words; Mosaic Covenant; reiteration of several of the laws; Moses face shines

Ch 35

Theme – Sabbath reminder repeated; call for free will offering for the Tabernacle; call for skillful workers to come forward; freewill offering collected; Bezalel and Oholiab placed over the work

Ch 36

Theme – Moses turns over the work to Bezalel & Oholiab; construction begins (curtains, boards, bars of acacia wood, veil, screen)

Ch 37

Theme – Description of construction continues (Ark, Table of Shewbread, Golden Lampstand, Altar of Incense)

Ch 38

Theme – Construction completed (Altar of Burnt Offering, Laver of Bronze, Court around the Tabernacle); total metal used

Ch 39

Theme – Priestly garments prepared; all of the work was completed; Moses examined the work and found that it was completed as instructed; Moses blessed the craftsmen

Ch 40

Theme – Tabernacle is erected; Moses and Aaron and priestly sons were consecrated; glory of the Lord filled the Tabernacle; the Tabernacle becomes the Tent of Meeting (previous one was in ch 33)
