**Theme – Moses granted ability to produce signs; protests his election; Aaron appointed as his mouthpiece**

**Theme – Moses confronts Pharaoh (1st TIME);  
Pharaoh increases Israel's labor**

**Ch 6**

**Theme – God speaks to Moses and affirms  
him; Moses delivers message to Israel but they  
do not listen; God tells Moses to speak to  
Pharaoh and Moses resists; list of the heads of  
Israel; repeat of God telling Moses to go to  
Pharaoh and Moses resist (I am unskilled in  
speech)**

**Ch 7**

**Theme – God promises to harden Pharaoh's  
heart and to stretch out His hand over Egypt;  
Moses is 88 yrs old and Aaron is 83 yrs old;  
Staff becomes a serpent; Plague #1 - water  
turned to blood for seven days**

**Ch 8**

**Theme – Plague #2 – frogs; Pharaoh asks Moses to take away the frogs; Plague #3 – Insects (gnats); Plague #4 – Flies (first plague with a noted difference between Israel and Egypt); Pharaoh agrees to let the people worship IN the land (do not go very far away); Moses prays for the plague to end and Pharaoh hardens his heart**

**Ch 9**

**Theme – Plague #5 – Pestilence on livestock; told that Lord set a definite time; Plague #6 – Boils; Moses told to throw soot from a kiln (bricks hardened in kilns) and soot would become fine dust that would become boils; Moses told to tell Pharaoh that God did not strike him down so that God's power could be proclaimed in all the earth; Plague #7 – Hail (hail and fire flashing continually); hail struck every man, beast, plant, and tree in the field; No hail in Goshen; Pharaoh asks for intercession, but changes his mind (hardens his heart) after the plague ends**

Ch 10

Theme – Plague #8 – Locusts; locust will eat whatever is left by the hail; Pharaoh tries to negotiate when he hears about the plague to come and gets mad at Moses when Moses wants to take all the people; Pharaoh asks for forgiveness; **GOD HARDENS PHARAOH'S HEART**; Plague #9 – Darkness; it is a darkness that can be felt for three days; Israel had light; Pharaoh agrees to let the people go worship God, but that they cannot take the animals; Pharaoh and Moses agree that they will never see each other again

Theme – Plague #10 – death of the firstborn announced

Ch 12

Theme – Passover instituted; Passover lamb described; told to prepare to leave in haste; Feast of Unleavened Bread described; blood on the lintels as symbol that God passed over their houses; Plague #10 occurs; Pharaoh expels Israel; Egyptians give wealth to Israel; 600,000 men on foot (those able to walk) leave plus women and children; told that in Egypt for 430 yrs; Passover declared to be an ordinance

**Ch 13**

**Theme – Firstborn is set aside (sanctified) to God; Passover/ Feast of Unleavened bread instituted as an annual rite; commanded to redeem every firstborn of man; told that this would be a memorial to future generations; God leads Israel to the Red Sea by a pillar of cloud by day and pillar of fire by night**

**Ch 14**

**Theme – God tells Moses that He is leading Israel in a way that will prompt Pharaoh to chase after Israel; Pharaoh has a change of heart; Israel becomes frightened and Moses tells them not to fear; Moses cries to God and tells Moses to command Israel to go through the Red Sea; God blocks Pharaoh's army with a pillar of cloud with darkness; Pharaoh's army swallowed by the sea**

**Theme – Song of Moses; Miriam called a prophetess; Miriam sings with the women; tested at waters of Marah (bittier); YHWH Rapha (Lord our healer); came to Elim with 12 springs of water and 70 date palms**

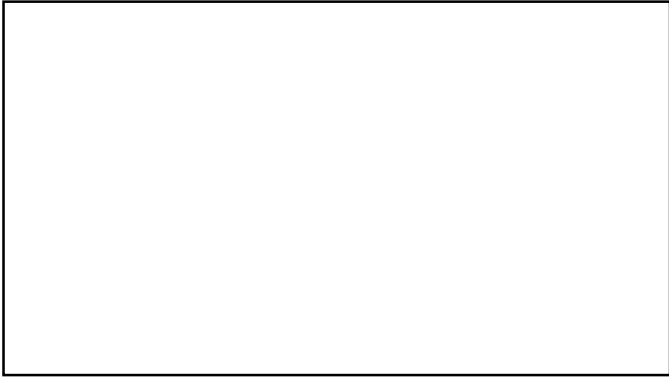

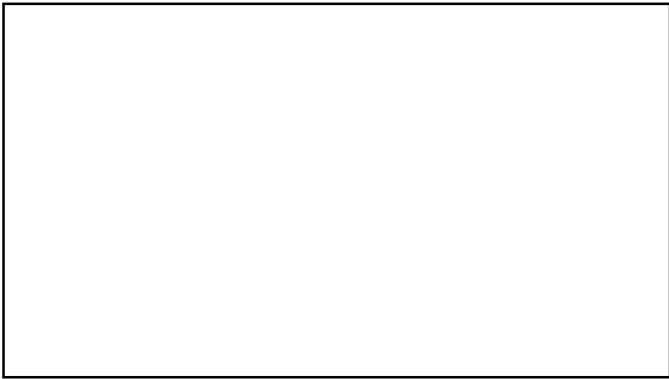
