Ch 9

Theme – Gibeonite deception; Israel makes a binding covenant with the Gibeonites

Ch 10

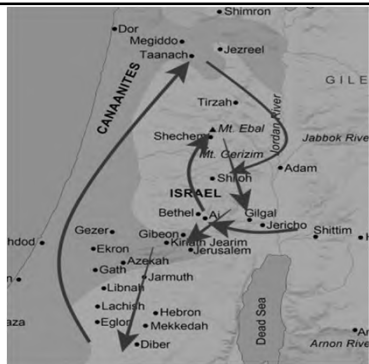
Theme – Battle with the five kings; God sends hailstones upon five kings; sun stands still; rest of southern Canaan delivered into Israel's hand

Ch 11

Theme – Kings of northern Canaan gather and fight against Israel, Israel defeats them and burns the city of Hazor; faithfulness of Joshua declared; giants cut off; end of the state of war

Ch 12

Theme – List of the kings defeated by Moses and Joshua



Ch 13

Theme – Joshua commanded to portion the remaining land to Israel; land given to 2 1/2 tribes on the East side of the Jordan

Ch 14

Theme – Land divided among 9 1/2 tribes on the West side of the Jordan; Caleb requests the portion promised to him by God (Hebron)

Ch 15

Theme – The allotment given to Judah (borders and cities)

Ch 16

Theme – Allotment given to the sons of Joseph (emphasis on Ephraim)

Ch 17

Theme – Allotment given to the sons of Joseph (emphasis on Manasseh); daughters of Zelophehad receive their portion; Ephraim and Manasseh demand more land

Ch 18

Theme – Joshua sends a surveying group out to divide the land into 7 tracts; casts lots to determine which tribe received what tract of land; Tribe of Benjamin receives their portion

Ch 19

Theme – Tribe of Simeon receives their portion (in the midst of Judah's portion); portions for tribe of Zebulun, Issachar, Asher, Naphtali, Dan; inheritance for Joshua

Ch 20

Theme – Cities of the refuge are assigned

Ch 21

Theme – Cities given to the Levites (cities given by tribe and by name)

Ch 22

Theme – 2 1/2 tribes sent to their possession; 2 1/2 tribes build an altar to act as a witness of their connection to the other tribes

Ch 23

Theme – Joshua charges the leaders of Israel to follow the Lord even after he is gone

Ch 24

Theme – Joshua tells Israel to choose whom they will serve; covenant is renewed; Joshua passes away; declaration of the faithfulness of the people during the days of Joshua and the days of the elders who served with him; burial of the bones of Joseph; passing of Eleazar the High Priest
