Now Rehoboam was forty-one years old when he began to reign, and he reigned seventeen years in Jerusalem, the city which the LORD had chosen from all the tribes of Israel, to put His name there. And his mother's name was Naamah the Ammonitess. 2Ch 12:14 He did evil because he did not set his heart to seek the LORD.	
2	Abijah (Abijam)	Bad	3 years	1 Kings 15:1	2 Chronicles 13:1	1Ki 15:1 Now in the eighteenth year of King Jeroboam, the son of Nebat, Abijam became king over Judah. 1Ki 15:3 He walked in all the sins of his father which he had committed before him; and his heart was not wholly devoted to the LORD his God, like the heart of his father David.	
3	Asa	Good	41 years	1 Kings 15:9	2 Chronicles 14:1	2Ch 14:2 Asa did good and right in the sight of the LORD his God,	2Ch 16:10 Then Asa was angry with the seer and put him in prison, for he was enraged at him for this. And Asa oppressed some of the people at the same time.
4	Jehoshaphat	Good	25 years	1 Kings 22:41	2 Chronicles 17:1	2Ch 17:3 The LORD was with Jehoshaphat because he followed the example of his father David's earlier days and did not seek the Baals, 2Ch 17:4 but sought the God of his father, followed His commandments, and did not act as Israel did.	2Ch 18:3 Ahab king of Israel said to Jehoshaphat king of Judah, "Will you go with me against Ramoth-gilead?" And he said to him, "I am as you are, and my people as your people, and we will be with you in the battle." 2Ch 20:35 After this Jehoshaphat king of Judah allied himself with Ahaziah king of Israel. He acted wickedly in so doing.

5	Jehoram (Joram)	Bad	8 years	1 Kings 22:50	2 Chronicles 21:1	<p>2Ch 21:5 Jehoram was thirty-two years old when he became king, and he reigned eight years in Jerusalem.</p> <p>2Ch 21:6 He walked in the way of the kings of Israel, just as the house of Ahab did (for Ahab's daughter was his wife), and he did evil in the sight of the LORD.</p>	
6	Ahaziah	Bad	1 years	2 Kings 8:24	2 Chronicles 22:1	<p>2Ch 22:2 Ahaziah was twenty-two years old when he became king, and he reigned one year in Jerusalem. And his mother's name was Athaliah, the granddaughter of Omri.</p> <p>2Ch 22:3 He also walked in the ways of the house of Ahab, for his mother was his counselor to do wickedly.</p> <p>2Ch 22:4 He did evil in the sight of the LORD like the house of Ahab, for they were his counselors after the death of his father, to his destruction.</p>	
7	Athaliah (Queen)			2 Kings 11:1	2 Chronicles 22:10	<p>2Ch 22:10 Now when Athaliah the mother of Ahaziah saw that her son was dead, she rose and destroyed all the royal offspring of the house of Judah.</p>	
8	Joash (Jehoash)	Good	40 years	2 Kings 11:4	2 Chronicles 23:1	<p>2Ki 12:2 Jehoash did right in the sight of the LORD all his days in which Jehoiada the priest instructed him.</p>	<p>2Ch 24:17 But after the death of Jehoiada the officials of Judah came and bowed down to the king, and the king listened to them.</p> <p>2Ch 24:18 They abandoned the house of the LORD, the God of their fathers, and served the Asherim and the idols; so wrath came upon Judah and Jerusalem for this their guilt.</p>

9	Amaziah	Good	29 years	2 Kings 14:1	2 Chronicles 25:1	<p>2Ch 25:1 Amaziah was twenty-five years old when he became king, and he reigned twenty-nine years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name was Jehoaddan of Jerusalem.</p> <p>2Ch 25:2 He did right in the sight of the LORD, yet not with a whole heart.</p>	<p>2Ch 25:14 Now after Amaziah came from slaughtering the Edomites, he brought the gods of the sons of Seir, set them up as his gods, bowed down before them and burned incense to them.</p> <p>2Ch 25:15 Then the anger of the LORD burned against Amaziah, and He sent him a prophet who said to him, "Why have you sought the gods of the people who have not delivered their own people from your hand?"</p>
10	Uzziah (Azariah)	Good	52 years	2 Kings 15:1	2 Chronicles 26:1	<p>2Ch 26:3 Uzziah was sixteen years old when he became king, and he reigned fifty-two years in Jerusalem; and his mother's name was Jechiliah of Jerusalem.</p> <p>2Ch 26:4 He did right in the sight of the LORD according to all that his father Amaziah had done.</p>	<p>2Ch 26:16 But when he became strong, his heart was so proud that he acted corruptly, and he was unfaithful to the LORD his God, for he entered the temple of the LORD to burn incense on the altar of incense.</p>
11	Jotham	Good	16 years	2 Kings 15:32	2 Chronicles 27:1	<p>2Ch 27:1 Jotham was twenty-five years old when he became king, and he reigned sixteen years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name was Jerushah the daughter of Zadok.</p> <p>2Ch 27:2 He did right in the sight of the LORD, according to all that his father Uzziah had done; however he did not enter the temple of the LORD. But the people continued acting corruptly.</p>	NONE!
12	Ahaz	Bad	16 years	2 Kings 15:38	2 Chronicles 28:1	<p>2Ch 28:1 Ahaz was twenty years old when he became king, and he reigned sixteen years in Jerusalem; and he did not do right in the sight of the LORD as David his father had done.</p>	

13	Hezekiah	Good (Best?)	29 years	2 Kings 18:1	2 Chronicles 29:1	<p>2Ch 29:1 Hezekiah became king when he was twenty-five years old; and he reigned twenty-nine years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name was Abijah, the daughter of Zechariah.</p> <p>2Ch 29:2 He did right in the sight of the LORD, according to all that his father David had done.</p>	<p>2Ki 20:13 Hezekiah listened to them, and showed them all his treasure house, the silver and the gold and the spices and the precious oil and the house of his armor and all that was found in his treasuries. There was nothing in his house nor in all his dominion that Hezekiah did not show them. 2Ki 20:17 'Behold, the days are coming when all that is in your house, and all that your fathers have laid up in store to this day will be carried to Babylon; nothing shall be left,' says the LORD. 2Ch 32:31 Even in the matter of the envoys of the rulers of Babylon, who sent to him to inquire of the wonder that had happened in the land, God left him alone only to test him, that He might know all that was in his heart.</p>
14	Manasseh	Bad (will repent)	55 years	2 Kings 21:1	2 Chronicles 33:1	<p>2Ch 33:1 Manasseh was twelve years old when he became king, and he reigned fifty-five years in Jerusalem. 2Ch 33:12 When he was in distress, he entreated the LORD his God and humbled himself greatly before the God of his fathers.</p> <p>2Ch 33:13 When he prayed to Him, He was moved by his entreaty and heard his supplication, and brought him again to Jerusalem to his kingdom. Then Manasseh knew that the LORD was God.</p> <p>2Ch 33:2 He did evil in the sight of the LORD according to the abominations of the nations whom the LORD dispossessed before the sons of Israel.</p>	

15	Amon	Bad	2 years	2 Kings 21:19	2 Chronicles 33:21	<p>2Ch 33:22 He did evil in the sight of the LORD as Manasseh his father had done, and Amon sacrificed to all the carved images which his father Manasseh had made, and he served them.</p> <p>2Ch 33:23 Moreover, he did not humble himself before the LORD as his father Manasseh had done, but Amon multiplied guilt.</p>
16	Josiah (8 yrs old; revival king)	Good	31 years	2 Kings 22:1	2 Chronicles 34:1	<p>2Ch 34:1 Josiah was eight years old when he became king, and he reigned thirty-one years in Jerusalem.</p> <p>2Ch 34:2 He did right in the sight of the LORD, and walked in the ways of his father David and did not turn aside to the right or to the left.</p> <p>2Ch 35:20 After all this, when Josiah had set the temple in order, Neco king of Egypt came up to make war at Carchemish on the Euphrates, and Josiah went out to engage him.</p> <p>2Ch 35:21 But Neco sent messengers to him, saying, "What have we to do with each other, O King of Judah? I am not coming against you today but against the house with which I am at war, and God has ordered me to hurry. Stop for your own sake from interfering with God who is with me, so that He will not destroy you."</p> <p>2Ch 35:22 However, Josiah would not turn away from him, but disguised himself in order to make war with him; nor did he listen to the words of Neco from the mouth of God, but came to make war on the plain of Megiddo.</p>

19	Jehoiakin (Jehoiachin/ Coniah/ Jeconiah)	Bad	3 months	2 Kings 24:6	2 Chronicles 36:9	2Ch 36:9 Jehoiachin was eight years old when he became king, and he reigned three months and ten days in Jerusalem, and he did evil in the sight of the LORD.
20	Zedekiah (Mattaniah)	Bad	11 years	2 Kings 24:17	2 Chronicles 36:11	2Ch 36:12 He did evil in the sight of the LORD his God; he did not humble himself before Jeremiah the prophet who spoke for the LORD.
